Right to vote - citizens of other EU countries

A voter who is a citizen of another EU Member State has the right to vote for the European Parliament in the Czech Republic provided that he/she is registered as a PERMANENT or TRANSITIONAL resident in the Czech Republic by Wednesday 24 April at the latest. In order for such a citizen of another EU Member State (hereinafter referred to as an "EU foreigner") to be able to vote in the European Parliament in the Czech Republic, he or she must, by 4 p.m. on Sunday 28 April, APPLY TO THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY in charge of his/her place of residence for registration on the list of voters for the European Parliament elections or for the transfer of data from the supplement to the permanent list of voters for the European Parliament elections (Article 29 (1) to (3) of Act of Law No. 62/2003 Coll., on Elections to the European Parliament, as amended).

The deadline for submitting the application is 28 April 2024 at 4 p.m.

If you, as an EU foreigner, wish to submit an application for registration on the list of voters or to transfer data from the supplement to the permanent list of voters, you can still contact us on Sunday 28 April 2024 by 4 p.m.
